As August came to a close, the M4M5 project reached a major milestone with the installation of the last gantry on the M4. With installations on the M4 complete, work on the M5 will now commence; a total of 6 gantries will be installed on the M5 throughout September.

<u>Traffic Management</u> – the use of cones and signs to provide lane and speed restrictions within the areas we need to work.

Full closures

Throughout August we will carry out a series of closures on the M5, M4 and within the Almondsbury Interchange.

3rd September

- M4 East and West 19-20
- M5 South to M4 West link road

 4^{th} , 5^{th} , 6^{th} , 18^{th} , 19^{th} , 20^{th} , 25^{th} 26^{th} & 27^{th} September

- M5 North junctions 17-16
- M5 South junctions 15-17

7th September

- M5 North junctions 16-15
- M5 North to M4 East and West link roads

11th, 12th, 13th September

- M5 North junctions 16-15
- M5 South junctions 14-15

17th September

- M4 East and West to M5 South link roads
- M5 junction 16 southbound offslip

21st September

- M5 junction 16 northbound onslip
- M5 North to M4 East and West link roads

24th September

 M5 South to M4 West and East link roads

Closures will be in effect from as early as **22:00hrs**, if traffic flows are low enough, however closures of slip roads and link roads within the Almondsbury Interchange may be in effect from the earlier time of **21:00hrs**.

All closures will be removed by 06:00hrs the following day.

NB. Carriageways that are to be closed will be reduced to single lane running prior to the closure time.

Construction Activities

Gantry installations

- Throughout September we will install a total of 6 new cross carriageway gantries on the M5.
- By the end of September we will have installed 19 of the 33 new gantries.
- The gantries will be installed at night during full closures of the carriageway. See above for details.

Foundation piling

• Piling in the verges of the M5 is 75% complete, with the majority of work expected to be complete by late September.

Gantry bases

- Work to construct the 66 bases that will support the new cross carriageway gantries is 75% complete.
- Work is expected to be complete in October.

Directional drilling

• Directional drilling so that technology cables can be passed beneath the carriageway is 66% complete.

Gabion walls

- Gabion walls, which are simply metal cages filled with rocks, are a cost effective and environmentally friendly method of ground reinforcement.
- The construction of gabion walls on the M4 and M5 will be completed in September.
