

# NOTICE OF ELECTION

South Gloucestershire Council

## Election of ONE Town Councillor for Bradley Stoke Town Council, South Ward

1. Forms of nomination for Parish/Town Elections may be obtained from Council Offices, Badminton Road, Yate, South Gloucestershire, BS37 5AF from the Returning Officer who will, at the request of an elector for any electoral area prepare a nomination paper for signature.
2. Nomination papers must be delivered to the Returning Officer, Council Offices, Badminton Road, Yate, South Gloucestershire, BS37 5AF on any day after the date of this notice but **no later than 4 pm on Friday, 28th February 2020.**
3. If an election is contested the poll will take place on **Thursday, 26th March 2020.**
4. Applications to register to vote must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by 12 midnight on **Tuesday 10 March 2020.** Applications can be made online: <https://www.gov.uk/register-to-vote>.
5. Applications, amendments or cancellations of postal votes and amendments or cancellations of proxy votes must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Council Offices, Badminton Road, Yate, South Gloucestershire, BS37 5AF by 5 pm on **Wednesday, 11th March 2020.**
6. New applications to vote by proxy at this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Council Offices, Badminton Road, Yate, South Gloucestershire, BS37 5AF by 5 pm on **Wednesday, 18th March 2020.**
7. Applications to vote by emergency proxy at this election on grounds of physical incapacity or for work/service reasons must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Council Offices, Badminton Road, Yate, South Gloucestershire, BS37 5AF by 5 pm on Thursday, 26th March 2020. The physical incapacity must have occurred after 5 pm on Wednesday, 18th March 2020. To apply on the grounds of work/service, the person must have become aware that they cannot go to the polling station in person after 5 pm on Wednesday, 18th March 2020
