Motion 2007 – 5 Provision of Healthcare in Bradley Stoke

At a meeting of Full Council on the 12th September 2007, the Council unanimously passed the following resolution which I have detailed below.

Motion 2007 – 5 Provision of Healthcare in Bradley Stoke

“This Council notes that Bradley Stoke is a major town in South Gloucestershire with a population approaching 25,000 people. It believes that healthcare provision in Bradley Stoke and surrounding areas has failed to keep pace with the development of the town, the requirements of its residents and those in surrounding communities. In particular it notes that there is currently no NHS dentistry provision within the town.

Council therefore resolves to write to the PCT urging them to reconsider their decision and commit to provide funding for an additional health centre in the town to include:

- Walk-in centre
- Dentistry
- Children’s clinic
- Base for Health visitors
- Pre and Post Natal Care
- Base for Midwives
- Family Planning clinic

As identified in the PCT’s own Needs Survey.
