JON CALLS FOR COMMONSENSE

No-one likes paying tax, but it's the way that local councils raise money to provide services that local residents need. Unfortunately the Conservatives now running Bradley Stoke Town Council seem to have forgotten that they are there to provide facilities and services to local people. Many of our community buildings stand empty because they are too expensive, almost twice as much to hire as in Patchway and Filton (even though the Council has cash reserves of over £200,000).
