

Pub Watch in your Area

We would like everyone to know that Pub Watch is now up and running in many of the pubs in Bradley Stoke and neighbouring areas Stoke Gifford, Little Stoke and Patchway. PC Steve Palmer has been working with the local pubs over the last few weeks to set the scheme up. The pubs currently part of the scheme are:

The Bradley Stoke, The Three Brooks, The Baileys Court, The Travellers Rest, The Parkway Tavern and The Beaufort Arms.

All pubs will be working together with the police to deal with any issues including anti-social behaviour, using and dealing drugs, assaults, criminal damage or any other issues that may arise.

Anyone found causing a problem in one pub, will be **BANNED** from all pubs listed for a period of 3 to 12 months and could lead to an ASBO.

The curfew is between 11pm to 7am with the exception of the following nights where the curfew will begin at different times:
